

Disposal of a workshop – main options

What to do with all the stuff – a good question!!

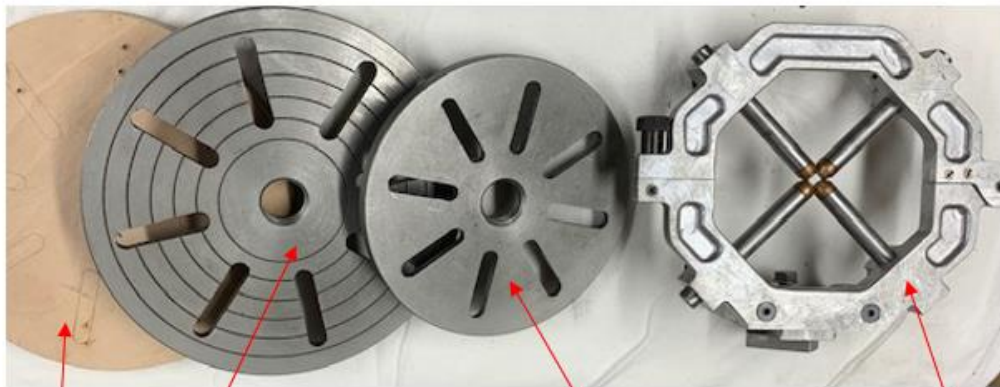
Option 1 – skip or dumpster – just the hire cost

Option 2 – get someone to purchase the complete workshop – this is likely to be a rock bottom price - say 20% of the value

Option 3 – Sell the main items and get more money

Buy a recent copy of Model Engineer to find dealers. Use eBay or Facebook market place. The remaining small stuff can be disposed.

Essential document:- All items should be photographed with a description to help the seller. The Quorn in the earlier post is a good example of problem the executors would have. I have a folder with ALL items identified with comments – doesn't take long to prepare. Below is an example.



10inch Myford face plate. In use parts are bolted to the face plate using the slots. The wooden disk can be attached to the face plate to allow parts to be screwed to the wood

7inch Myford face plate for use like the 10inch

Dore Fixed steady. Bolts to the lathe bed and the brass tips run on the part being turned to stabilize. Typically a long length of tube or rod
