THE FLAP LOCKING MECHANISM HAS THE POSSIBILITY OF

DISENGAGING CAUSING UN-COMMANDED FLAP

RETRACTION.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Remove old SC32204-001 part and replace with SC32204-001

revision F.

FLAP HANDLE LOCK REPLACEMENT PROCEDURE:



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- Remove existing SC32204-001 by removing hardware as shown in Figure 1. Retain hardware and discard SC32204-001 and cotter pin.
- Rotate flap lever arm fore and aft while applying pressure inboard or outboard to center and align flap cross bar with fuselage centerline as necessary.
- Install SC32204-001 Revision F using same hardware and new cotter pin (AN380-2-2). SC32204-001 should be centered thru flap lever slot (see Figure 2). Additional washers (AN960-10 or AN960-10L) may be used to shim SC32204-001 to achieve center position. Do not use more than 4 washers per side to shim.



- Ensure flaps work properly and all positions lock. Ensure no interference is occurring between flap lever and fuselage or any other components.
- 5. Make logbook entry "Service Bulletin SB00005 complied with".
- If any discrepancies found, Contact Cub Crafters, Inc. prior to next flight.
